The CLSP Academy brings together practitioners, content experts, and community representatives who are dedicated to creating change. Academy staff instruct communitybased teams on how to strengthen and sustain coalitions, use data to drive strategic planning, improve community readiness, and focus programming on disproportionately impacted populations. Participants leave the Academy with a preliminary coalition action plan, preparing them to have the greatest impact in their communities.

Education Development Center (EDC) developed the Community-Led Suicide Prevention framework for coalition members and practitioners who want to take a comprehensive approach to suicide prevention in their communities. EDC's online <u>CLSP Toolkit</u> at clsp.edc.org offers coalitions a step-by step process for effective real-world changes.

The CLSP framework was inspired by The National Action Alliance for Suicide Prevention's <u>Transforming Communities report</u>. CLSP also aligns with the four Strategic Directions outlined in the <u>National</u> <u>Strategy for Suicide Prevention (NSSP)</u>. Released by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services in April 2024, the NSSP is a bold plan that centers community-led efforts in the fight against suicide. CLSP provides prevention coalitions with a structure and strategy for achieving the plan's ambitious goals.
