


Multi-Tiered Suicide Prevention for Schools

Multi-Tiered Suicide Prevention (MTSP) for Schools is your district's guide to embedding suicide prevention into your multi-tiered systems of support.



EDC's MTSP for Schools is an evidence-based framework that helps schools align effective, comprehensive suicide prevention strategies within existing multi-tiered systems of support. MTSP enables schools to invest in sustainable environmental changes for impactful suicide prevention.

Providing high-quality academic instruction in the same environment that promotes student wellbeing and prevents suicides is possible. We offer technical assistance schools can use to implement six evidence-based components of school suicide prevention:

- → Engaging school community
- Developing community partnerships
- → Developing protocols for helping students at risk
- → Developing protocols for after a death by suicide
- → Identifying and supporting students who are at risk
- Promotion of protective factors

MTSP for Schools in Your District

Single District Service

- → Districts partner directly with EDC to develop 1-3 key components of MTSP for Schools over the course of 1 school year.
- → EDC's direct technical assistance provides customized guidance and support uniquely addressing a district's identified needs

Multi-District Service

State departments, local education agencies, and nonprofits partner with EDC to bring multiple school districts together through a collaborative peer learning model that supports districts in developing all 6 key components of school suicide prevention over the course of two school years or more.

Through professional development and coaching, EDC supports districts in assessing their existing suicide prevention efforts, strategically planning for comprehensive suicide prevention, and implementing and improving evidence-based strategies to prevent student suicide.

MTSP Impact

EDC is currently working with large and small, urban and rural school districts across diverse states to implement MTSP for Schools. Data from past participating districts has shown substantial increases in reported capacity to fill gaps in suicide prevention best practices and prevent student suicide.
